To provide due care to the helpless and destitute and senior citizens in the society and even those aged persons neglected by the family and do not get proper care due to challenging circumstances in life, so that they lives as valued members of the society with happy, holistic and healthy minds .

Goal:

To ensure a sound and friendly environment for the underprivileged and destitute senior citizens towards achieving a promising peaceful conditions for them fostering their physical, mental, social and spiritual development and wellbeing as well.

Purpose of the project:

To ensure access of 50 underprivileged and destitute senior citizens at Swami Vivekanand Vruddharashram, Saoner, Nagpur to give them safe accommodation, tender love, proper care, nourishment, health service and other basic needs. Also, provide gainful employment to the working staff their as means of managing facility. This facility is run and managed by Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Technical and Education Society, Nagpur since 01st July 1991 now. We are hosting total 50 male and female residents currently at the facility. The main objective of our senior citizen home facility is to provide safe, secure and homely environment to the elderly people.

We have modern infrastructure facility with different wards for male and female elderly persons. We have round the clock staff to monitor their daily activity. The old age home is situated at Waghmare Layout, Paliyawada Saoner-Kalmeshwar Road, Saoner District-Nagpur.

They are facilitated with television with more than satellite channels, facilities like carom, chess, etc. is also made available for their entertainment. The RTM Society gives more focus on their health and so medical facilities are also provided all the needy people. In case of emergency a medical practitioner is made available on regular basis.

Highlight Events of the year 2020-2021

- **Social Audit of Swami Vivekanand Old Age Home**

It is a matter of pride for the facility that, on an experimental basic Social Audit was conducted for the first time in Maharashtra State. Only two NGO's running Old Age Homes were selected for the 3 days visit detailed Social Audit by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment which happened from 29th Jan 2021 to 31st Jan 2021.

As we in the middle of pandemic, senior citizens are the most vulnerable group during these tough times. At our facility, since the starting of lockdown, strict measure were taken to ensure proper care to fight novel corona virus. Mask and Sanitizers were provided to all the beneficiary to prevent from corona virus.

As soon as the vaccination programme was declared by the Govt. of India we took immediate action to ensure vaccination be provided to all the member at the facility. First leg of vaccine was conducted from 5th March 2021 to 15th March 2021 in accordance Primary Healthcare Centre, Saoner. Our in-house Doctor Mrs. Neha Singh along with Nurse Kanchan Ingole and others made the drive succesful.

- **Birth Anniversary Celebration of Our Founder Late Dr. Yogesh Kumbhalkar**

This idea of starting this facility was brain child of our beloved Founding Secretary of Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Technical & Education Society Late Dr. Yogesh Kumbhalkar. 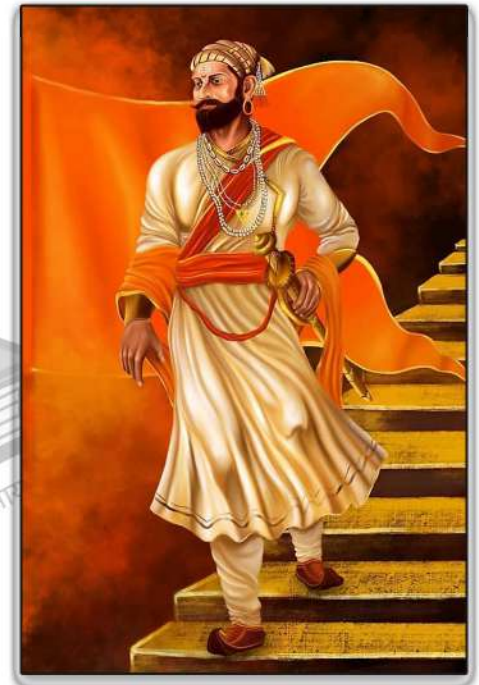

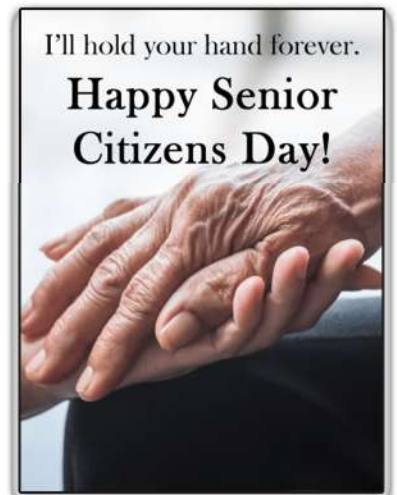
